Vaccines

We are asking everyone to get their vaccines if they haven't already and to get a booster if you have - it's not too late.

We're asking employers to encourage their staff to book an appointment via the [national booking system](#) (those 18+ can now do this) or visit one of the local [pop up vaccination clinics](#). There are a number of these across Manchester, including in the City Centre, Newton Heath, and Whalley Range. There are options for you and your staff to go at lunchtime, or after work.

Covid Pass Regulations

The new COVID Pass regulations came into effect at 6am on Thursday 15 December. This means that certain organisations (event organisers, venues, businesses) are now required to use COVID-19 status checks as a condition of entry.
